- 1. Call to Order @ 7:15pm
- 2. Roll Call all present.
- 3. Wood made a motion to switch items 1 and 2 under New Business. With the by-laws being reviewed first and the DRAFT MP second. Wood made a motion to approve the agenda with those changes, Krueger second, motion carried.
- 4. Public participation for agenda items heard
- 5. Minutes from June 20<sup>th</sup> were read. Krueger made a motion to approve the minutes, M. Evans second, motion carried.
- 6. Unfinished business
  - 1. Lakes to Land Regional Initiative with Beckett & Raeder
    - 1. Betsy gave a report on the Lakes to Land Priorities meeting. She explained the top four project oriented goals: 1)roads/trails 2)Bridge over the Betsie River 3)Dump Day 4)Zoning implementation. Betsy also shared the top 10 goals for the entire L2L region. 1)Trails system 2)Infrastructure 3)Economic development 4)Specific regulations and zoning 5)Blight 6)Expand recreation opportunity 7)Water quality 8)Agriculture 9)M-22 scenic hwy 10)Improve communications
    - 2. Continued discussion was had on the future land use map specifically concerning the extension of the commercial area east down Hoadley Rd and further southeast down M115. Commission members expressed concern about demand/need for this much commercial space however comparison was made to the land use map of the former MP for zoning under Benzie County. Continued time for thought on this commercial designed area was given.
