Project History


- I. 2013: Original Plans prepared in 2013 by Beckett & Raeder, Inc. and submitted for MDNR Michigan Natural Resources Trust Fund grant by the Alliance for Economic Success.
- II. Spring 2015: AES secures MNRTF Grant.
- III. May 2015: BRI began revising the Site Plan submitted in the grant application. Updated topographic survey completed in June.
- IV. Discussed implications of change in topography and shoreline with Grant administrator.
- V. June 29, 2015: Reviewed site conditions and initial concept with MDEQ and Stakeholder Team. Meeting with MDEQ was to gain input on how to address change in topography and loss of accessible shoreline.
- VI. July 22, 2015: Met with MDEQ and USACE for additional input on topographical changes and to gain input on the proposed revised plan. Followed up meeting with correspondence with MDEQ Bottomlands, for additional input regarding long-term implications of constructing in High Risk Erosion on this specific site.
- VII. Updated and refined plans to bring project to Design Development level.

Review with the Stakeholder Team and input from MDEQ and USACE helped shape the revised plans.



The small red outline within the green outline represents the approximate work limits.












Design Development Plan - Option 'A'


